

Nominating Committee Report WOMR / Summer 2023

With three board members (treasurer Tony Pierson and directors Justine Alten and Breon Dunnigan) terming off in late 2023, the committee met in April to discuss potential replacements. With geographic and cultural diversity in mind, the committee suggested some names as possible candidates to serve on the board and also on the community advisory board.

In addition, the executive director was also approached by three of our current volunteers about serving on the board; these three have been selected to run for the seats being vacated by the above-mentioned vacancies. They are Mike Fee (Truro), Fran Sullivan (Wellfleet) and Mary Martin (Provincetown).

The other two incumbents from the class of 2023 (Sheila House and Fred Boak) will run for their seats for a second term at the annual meeting in November.

There are five members on the nominating committee, voted on by members at the 2022 annual meeting. They include:
