Approval of Minutes

Motion to approve the minutes of the May 15, 2025 meeting:

No discussion, motion passed unanimously.

Finance Committee Report

- Year-to-date surplus of \$100,000
- Revenue up \$71,000 over last year; expenses up \$9,000
- Underwriting up slightly, credited to Kirsten's efforts
- Pledges higher for Spring Drive; Summer Drive has raised \$33,000 to date
- Automobile donations down compared to last year
- Salaries up compared to last year
- CDs renewing at lower rates
- The first eight months of income are 84% of the annual budget; expenses 69%
- Building next year's budget will be challenging due to potential loss of CPB funding. If there are any expected expenses, they should be addressed sooner rather than later.
- During the Summer Drive, the station will communicate CPB funding uncertainties to listeners.
- Operating objective: maintain \$300,000 in reserves

Preliminary next-year budget shows a deficit of \$50,000

Executive Director's Report

- **Summer Drive**: \$33,000 raised prior to official start
- Events:
 - Wellfleet Sprint Triathlon was successful
 - o 1950s Radio Broadcast at the UU Church also successful
 - Fiddle & the Harp DJs planning fundraiser at Preservation Hall late
 September
 - Carnival Parade float planned
 - Mondaze events at Prez Hall planned through September
 - Meet & Greet planned at Devil's Purse Brewery
- John emphasized the importance of maintaining a presence in Provincetown.

Broadcast Issues

- Mt. Gilboa Renovation:
 - Town upgrades will require changes to the antenna feedline; estimated cost up to \$15,000
 - Need to replace and bury part of the feedline
 - Exploring alternative broadcast solutions (e.g., temporary antenna on shed to avoid auxiliary transmitter interference); costs to be determined.

Strategic Roadmap

- Action items from the roadmap will be included as standing agenda items going forward.
- The roadmap will be shared on the website, with grantors, and in the newsletter.

- The development committee is reviewing donor management software.
- The HR committee is working on the employee handbook.

- The policy committee has not been meeting regularly.
- The building and data committees are inactive.
- **Discussion:** Committees need to meet more often; this will be near the top of the next agenda.

Other Business

- Determine whether to schedule an August meeting or take a summer recess and reconvene in September.
- Share the donor management software research report with the full board.
- Reach out to Policy Committee members to confirm their continued participation.
