Meeting called to order at 4:04pm

Approval of Minutes

Upon motion of Ira Wood and seconded by Denya LeVine the Committee unanimously voted to approve the minutes of the November 19 meeting.

Program Proposals and Program Updates

Matt discussed the approval of proposals from Mat Coes and David Michael Ganye, noting that David Michael will have his first official show on Sunday.

Mike Giolongo declined offer of Saturday night slot.

Matt mentioned the availability of an open Sunday night slot and the success of Christmas specials organized by Eric the Red.

Fred Boak's Christmas in Hell special was discussed, with suggestions for it to be moved to a more appropriate time slot.

Matt updated the Committee on the training progress of new DJs, including Rachel Thayer and Phil Fournier, noting Phil's lack of progress and the need for more training sessions.

DJ Training

Scott Bonwell has an appointment with Matt during the first week of January.

David Siegler's proposed to host a remote show on Saturday night and Matt noticed his positive attitude and past contributions to the station. This led to a discussion of a policy to give local DJs preference over remote DJs. Andy moved for approval of one Saturday per month seconded by Ira. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of Mr. Seigler 's show temporarily.

The DJ handbook is mostly complete and includes videos on using equipment.

Other Matters

Matt outlined the schedule for program reviews, including assigning committee members to programs and soliciting self-evaluations from DJs.

The committee discussed the importance of having DJs connect with the local audience and serve the mission of the radio station.

John Braden suggested improving communication with overnight DJs, who may not receive fundraising updates.

The committee agreed to consider making a donation to the church for the use of their meeting space and to extend an invitation for the church to come on the station.
